The Chamber will be selling advance tickets again this year. One sheet of 20 tickets will be \$10. You will be able to buy tickets at the carnival \$1 each, 25 for \$20, or 40 for \$30. All rides will take either 2, 3, or 4 tickets per ride. Another Reminder of the Compost Dump Rules

One person can ruin our free dump for everyone. We have been having an issue with people dumping things in the compost dump that are not allowed. The City has a permit from the State and will lose that permit if the rules are not followed. If this happens it will mean extra costs for residents to have a way of dumping grass clippings and limbs. The **ONLY** items allowed at the compost pile are: grass clippings, leaves, garden waste and tree limbs (in their respective locations). **NO OTHER WOOD ITEMS ARE ALLOWED. PLASTIC BAGS WITH CLIPPINGS OR LEAVES ARE NOT PERMITTED.**
