Utility Billing Changes

On October 9th, the City Council passed Ordinance No: 378 which makes the

following changes:

-New tenants and homeowners will be required to pay a \$300 connection deposit for electrical service. If the customer signs up for auto pay, the deposit will be reduced to \$150. The customer must remain on auto pay or pay the additional \$150 to satisfy the \$300 connection deposit. Owners will be credited back their deposit fee after 12 consecutive months of no late payments.

-Utility bills are due the 25th of each month, if the 25th falls on a weekend or holiday, the bills will become due on the next normal business day. Bills not paid by noon on the 26th of each month will be considered delinquent and will be assessed a \$15 fee.

-Delinquent utility accounts will be subject to disconnection on the 10th of the month.

-Disconnected utility accounts will be assessed a reconnection fee of \$30 during regular business hours and \$100 for reconnections after hours, on weekends and holidays.

-Reconnection for disconnected utility accounts will only be made once the past due amount and the reconnection fees have been paid in full.

-Only 2 payment arrangements for past due accounts will be accepted per calendar year.
